Milne Center at Mystic Aquarium

completed 2020

This user-friendly, energy-efficient facility, delivered on time and on budget, was a years-long culmination of planning, communication, and collaboration led by Mark. He oversaw the entire process, from concept design to install. Tenji's extensive prefab, including a 22,000-gallon tank, allowed for a one-month installation despite requiring ten full truckloads of material.

Birch Aquarium at Scripps

completed 2018

Thanks to Tenji, this aquarium houses the largest seadragon exhibit in the world. Mark, as project manager and lead designer, constructed a highly specialized LSS to create the perfect conditions for this sensitive species. The aquarium has now entrusted Mark and the Tenji team with designing and building an 18,000-gallon habitat for little blue penguins.
